Surveys were conducted with participation of Methow Valley School District students, community members, and the Town Council.

Two open houses were held to gain feedback on draft plans for the park.



MAKING IT A REALITY

In 2021, with volunteer assistance from a landscape architect, preliminary drawings were developed showing activities and spaces within the park, with the main attraction continuing to be the existing pump track.

A four-phase plan with cost estimates was created to be the guide for this ambitious and worthy project.






